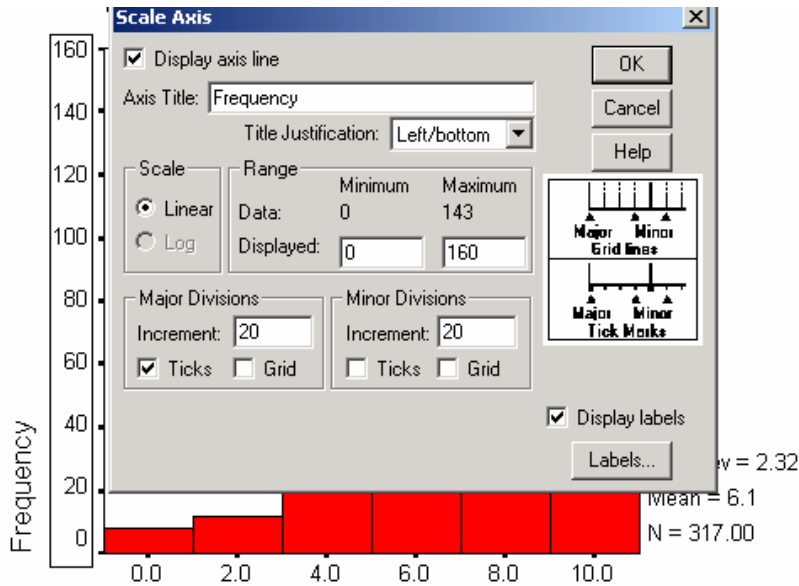


Editing Axis Labels for Histograms

Editing the Y axis

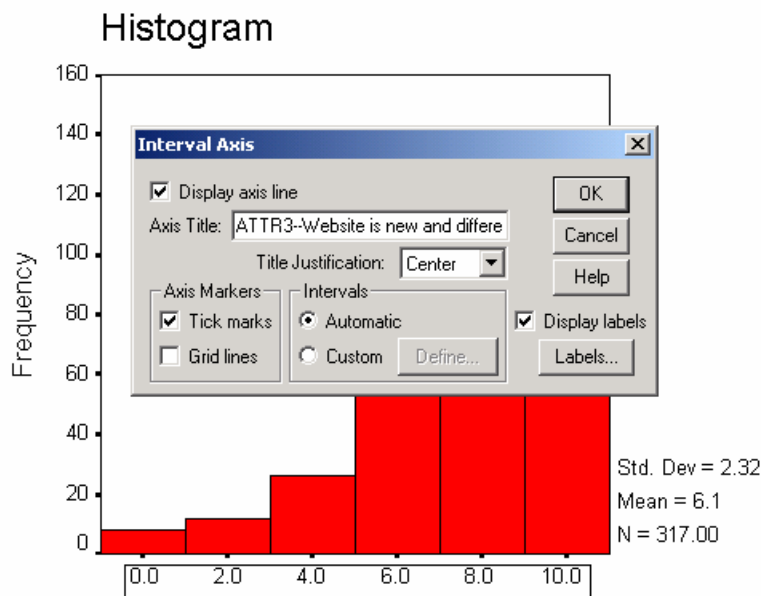
- * Double click on the graph to open the graph editor
- * Click on the Y axis to bring up this screen
- * You can change the title, range, and increments from this screen

Editing the X Axis

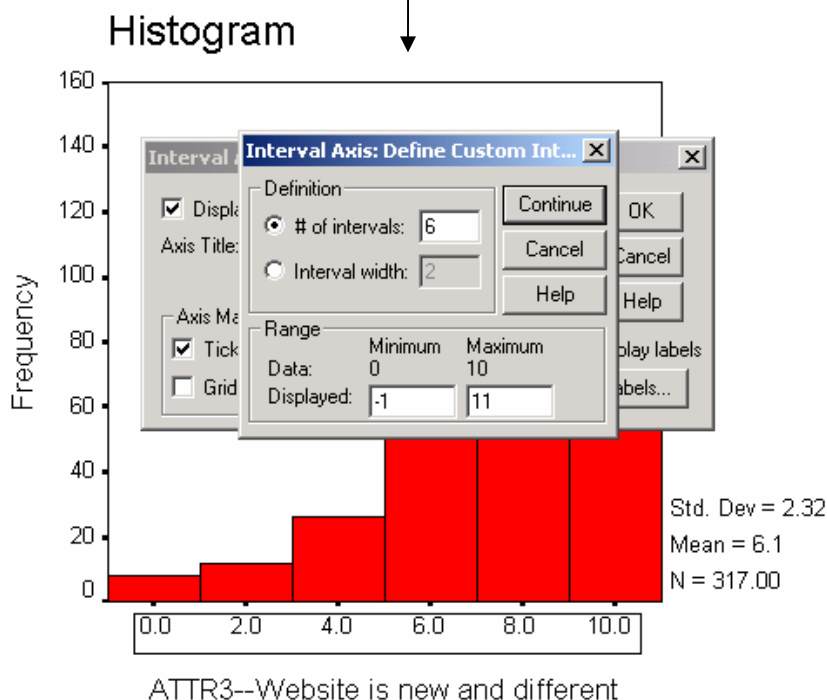
- * To bring up the graph editor double click on the graph.
- * To format the X axis double click on it.
- * This will bring up this screen

Editing the X Axis (Continued)

- * Under **intervals** select **custom** (the default in automatic)
- * Click on **define** to set your X axis
- * This will bring up this screen



Editing the X Axis (Continued)

- * Select **# of intervals** under **definition** and specify the number of intervals (bars) you want. (in this example the scale goes from 0-10 so we would want 11 intervals)
- * Select **Interval width** under **definition** and set width desired (in this case we would like an interval of 1)
- * Set your **range** next – because SPSS will label each bar by the range or the midpoint you need to set your range for a half an interval below and above the minimum (in this case -0.5 and 10.5). Also remember that your interval width must be an even multiple of the width.
